What is a BOG Resolution?

You may have heard, or may soon hear, about BOG resolutions because the <u>Board of Governors (BOG)</u> is meeting prior to the <u>IM23 Meeting</u> in San Diego. So, what is a BOG resolution? A BOG resolution may address any topic or issue of interest to the initiating member. It is a means for the grassroots membership to have formal input to the policy making body of the College. It often leads to ACP advocating to things which ARE or WILL be very important to you and your patients.

Did you know?

The Spring 2023 BOG Resolution num ber 10 is about ACP **advocating AGAINST non-compete clauses** in physician employment contracts.

Non-Compete Clauses may:

- deprive a community of medical services
- contribute to crisis of physician shortages
- Disrupt continuity of care
- Disallows a physician to practice with a competitor
- Prevent physicians from leaving an unfair or unhealthy employment relationship
- Physicians may have to move out of their state or community to avoid violation
- Contribute to physician burn out and dissatisfaction

Physicians are commonly presented with contracts that include Non-Compete Clauses. ACP is taking action to protect patients, communities and physicians.
